Adopted by the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Business Management and Social Sciences on March 13, 2024, approved by the University Steering Committee on April 10, 2024, approved by the Foundation Board on April 11, 2024, published on April 26, 2024 with effect from September 1, 2024

Section 1
Foreign Language Skills

- (1) Applicants must be able to demonstrate an adequate level of English, at least at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Proof shall be provided by submitting a certificate or by passing a language proficiency test.
- (2) Notwithstanding section 1 paragraph 2 sentence 2 of the university's Registration Regulations, applicants with a foreign higher education entrance qualification that is recognized as equivalent must be able to demonstrate an adequate level of German, at least at level A1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Proof shall be provided by submitting a certificate or by passing a written language proficiency test.

Entry into Force

¹These regulations shall enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Gazette of Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences with effect from the beginning of the application period for the winter semester 2024/2025. ²The Regulations Governing Proof of Additional Admission Requirements of June 30, 2017 for this degree program will expire at the same time.
